conference.


We want to devote this issue of the MAP Update to the conference, reviewing it for those who were there, and introducing some of the highlights to those who were not able to attend. —Paul Miller








Throughout the conference, we recorded seventeen sessions, which include testimonies, sermons, and the following eight sessions: Anabaptist Movement, Culture
