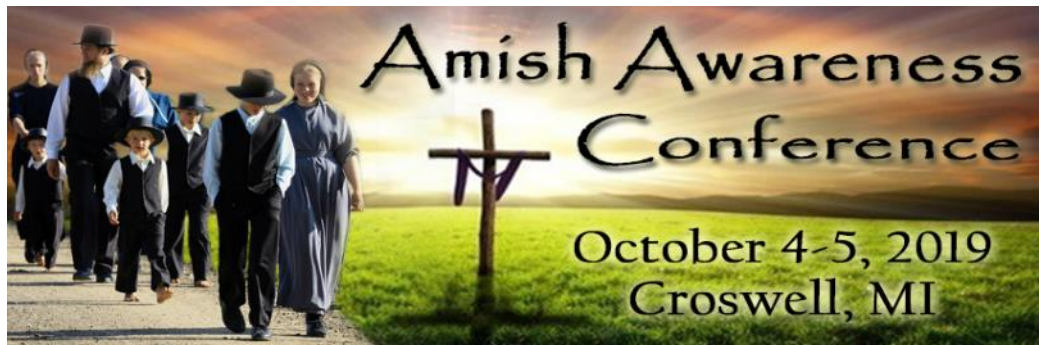
**A New Girod!**
