OUR THREE-FOLD PURPOSE:

1. Evangelize and disciple Amish and former Amish people:

This is being accomplished through personal witness, home Bible studies, home prayer meetings, the Bible Club, Amish Voice, and the audio ministry. MAP also offers counseling and protection to those who are victims of sexual, mental, and physical abuse.

- 2. Assist older teenagers and young adults who have already left the Amish culture by providing basic life skills such as:
 - Communicating with English as a second language.
 - Receiving driving lessons for obtaining a vehicle operator's license.
 - Learning new cultural norms, expectations, and social practices.
 - Applying for a Social Security card and completing employment applications.
 - Studying for high school GED testing and considering higher educational levels.
 - Preparing for job interviews, finding a residence, and acquiring home furnishings.
 - Opening bank accounts and understanding practical financial management practices.
- 3. Expand MAP all over North America.

Since the establishment of MAP in February of 2000, the founders have traveled throughout the United States presenting the ministry to local churches. The goal of MAP is to pass the burden on to others, so that they too, can help reach Amish people throughout the US and Canada.
