We know that faith is important. However, in what or in whom should our faith be? In Jesus? Our religion? Our good works? In ourselves? A combination of things? Explain.

Read Romans 10:17. If faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God, then how can we have faith if we do not read, know, and believe God's Word? Do you daily read God's Word? Do you believe all of it? Have you ever read the Bible all the way through? Describe your devotional life. When, how, etc., do you spend time with God, reading His Word and praying?

Often a Christian's faith gets tested. When we are tested with trials and difficulty, we either are drawn nearer to God, seeking Him more, or we turn against Him in anger and doubt. Have we ever any reason to doubt that God loves us and cares about us? How should you react when experiencing trials and difficulties?

Abraham left his land. He also was willing to sacrifice his son. David fought Goliath. Daniel went to the lions' den. Joseph was sold into slavery and spent years in prison, yet did nothing wrong to deserve that. Faith might mean doing that which we do not understand or would not choose to do on our own, but following God, trusting Him that He is doing what is right, even if we must endure misunderstanding, rejection, pain, and suffering. Is God worth serving—is Jesus worth following in faith, no matter what the cost or situation?

Read Psalm 119:11. Do you hide God's Word in your heart, that you will not sin against Him? Do you hate sin as God does? If we do not hide God's Word (the Bible) in our hearts, then we are in actuality sinning. How can one who knows and loves God doubt Him—He who has never lied or broken a promise, and who sent His own Son to die for us, when we were still sinners? Do you love Him? Do you trust Him? Do you hide God's Word in your heart by reading the Scriptures and loving and knowing and obeying them?
